AS LONG AGO AS 1957, U.S. ARMY SPECIAL FORCES SOLDIERS WERE IN THE REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM. GOING ABOUT THEIR BUSINESS OF TRAINING, ADVISING, AND ASSISTING MEMBERS OF THE VIETNAMESE ARMY. DESPITE THE OLD ARMY WITTICISM ABOUT NEVER VOLUNTEERING FOR ANYTHING, THE SPECIAL FORCES SOLDIER IS. IN FAN, A DOUBLE VOLUNTEER, HAVING FIRST VOLUNTEERED FOR AIRBORNE TRAINING AND THEN AGAIN FOR SPECIAL FORCES TRAINING. FROM A VERY MEAGER BEGINNING BUT SUSTAINED BY A STRONG MOTIVATION AND CONFIDENCE IN HIS MISSION, THE SPECIAL FORCES SOLDIER HAS MARCHED THROUGH THE VIETNAM STRUGGLE IN SUPERB FASHION. IN 1957 SOME FIFTY-EIGHT VIETNAMESE SOLDIERS WERE GIVEN MILITARY TRAINING BY SPECIAL FORCES TROOPS. TEN YEARS LATER THE SPECIAL FORCES WERE ADVISING AND ASSISTING OVER 40,000 PARAMILITARY TROOPS, ALONG WITH ANOTHER 40,000 REGIONAL FORCES AND POPULAR FORCES SOLDIERS. THIS MONOGRAPH TRACES THE DEVELOPMENT AND NOTES THE PROGRESS, PROBLEMS, SUCCESSES, AND FAILURES OF A UNIQUE PROGRAM UNDERTAKEN BY THE U.S. ARMY FOR THE FIRST TIME IN ITS HISTORY. IT IS HOPED THAT ALL THE SIGNIFICANT LESSONS LEARNED HAVE BEEN RECORDED AND THE MANY PITFALLS OF SUCH A PROGRAM UNCOVERED. WITH THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE SPECIAL FORCES FROM VIETNAM IN 1971, THE ARMY COULD HONESTLY LAY CLAIM TO A NEW DIMENSION IN GROUND WARFARE—THE ORGANIZED EMPLOYMENT OF A PARAMILITARY FORCE IN SUSTAINED COMBAT AGAINST A DETERMINED ENEMY. I KNOW I SPEAK FOR MY PREDECESSORS AND SUCCESSORS IN CLAIMING THAT THE 5TH SPECIAL FORCES GROUP (AIRBORNE) WAS THE FINEST COLLECTION OF PROFESSIONAL SOLDIERS EVER ASSEMBLED BY THE U.S. ARMY, ANYWHERE, ANYTIME. FROM THE PREFACE: THE FOLLOWING PAGES PROVIDE A NARRATIVE ANALYSIS OF THE U.S. ARMY'S DEVELOPMENT OF ARMORED ORGANIZATIONS AND THEIR RELATED DOCTRINE, MATERIEL, AND TRAINING ACTIVITIES IN THE PERIOD 1917-1945. THIS PERIOD MARKED THE EMERGENCE OF CLEAR PRINCIPLES OF ARMORED WARFARE THAT BECAME THE UNDERPINNING OF THE ARMOR BRANCH, INFLUENCING ARMORED DEVELOPMENTS LONG AFTER WORLD WAR II ENDED. A UNIQUE STYLE OF MOUNTED MANEUVER COMBAT EMERGED THAT REFLECTED A MIX OF TRADITION AN INNOVATION. IN THE PROCESS, AMERICAN MILITARY CULTURE CHANGED, PARTICULARLY THROUGH THE ADOPTION OF COMBINED-ARMS PRINCIPLES. CONVERSELY, POLITICAL ACTIONS, BUDGETARY CONSIDERATIONS, AND SENIOR LEADERSHIP DECISIONS ALSO SHAPED THE COURSE OF ARMOR DEVELOPMENT. THE EMERGENCE OF AN AMERICAN ARMORED FORCE INVOLVED MORE THAN SIMPLY TANK DEVELOPMENT. IT INCLUDED THE CREATION OF AN ARMORED DIVISION STRUCTURE STEEPED IN COMBINED-ARMS PRINCIPLES, ORGANIZATIONAL FLEXIBILITY, AND REVOLUTIONARY COMMAND AND CONTROL PROCESSES. PARALLEL DEVELOPMENTS INCLUDED THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SPECIALIZED UNITS TO PROVIDE ANTITANK, RECONNAISSANCE, AND INFANTRY SUPPORT CAPABILITIES. SEVERAL ARMY BRANCHES PLAYED A ROLE IN DETERMINING THE PRECISE PATH OF ARMORED DEVELOPMENT, AND ONE OF THEM—THE CAVALRY—BECAME A CASUALTY AS A RESULT.

THE THIRD OBJECTIVE IS TO ACCORD A WELL-EARNED RECOGNITION TO THE DEVOTED WORK AND GRIM SACRIFICES OF THOSE WHO SERVED. "THE SUCCESSES OF THE SOUTH PACIFIC FORCE," WROTE ADMIRAL HALSEY IN 1944, "WERE NOT THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF SEPARATE SERVICES OR INDIVIDUALS BUT THE RESULT OF WHOLE-HEARTED SUBORDINATION OF SELF-INTEREST BY ALL IN ORDER THAT ONE SUCCESSFUL 'FIGHTING TEAM' COULD BE CREATED."* THE HISTORY OF ANY SOUTH PACIFIC CAMPAIGN MUST DEAL WITH THIS "FIGHTING TEAM," WITH ALL UNITED STATES AND ALLIED SERVICES. THE VICTORY ON GUADALCANAL CAN BE UNDERSTOOD ONLY BY AN APPRECIATION OF THE CONTRIBUTION OF EACH SERVICE. NO ONE SERVICE WON THE BATTLE. THE MOST DECISIVE ENGAGEMENT OF THE CAMPAIGN WAS THE AIR AND NAVAL BATTLE OF GUADALCANAL IN MID-NOVEMBER 1942, AN ENGAGEMENT IN WHICH NEITHER ARMY NOR MARINE CORPS GROUND TROOPS TOOK ANY DIRECT PART. THIS VOLUME ATTEMPTS TO SHOW THE CONTRIBUTION OF ALL SERVICES TO THE FIRST VICTORY ON THE LONG ROAD TO TOKYO.

TO A LARGE EXTENT, THE SUCCESS OR FAILURE OF THE OFFENSIVE DEPENDED ON WHAT HAPPENED THERE. THE BATTLES TELL US MUCH ABOUT HOW THE ENEMY PREPARED FOR THE OFFENSIVE, WHY HE ACHIEVED A HIGH DEGREE OF SURPRISE AND INITIAL SUCCESS, AND WHY HIS ATTACKS ULTIMATELY FAILED. THE BATTLE FOR QUANG TRI CITY, A TEXTBOOK EXAMPLE OF A VERTICAL ENVELOPMENT, RESULTED IN A QUICK ALLIED VICTORY. THE FIGHT FOR HUE TURNED INTO A SLOW, GRINDING CAMPAIGN OF ATTRITION THAT LASTED NEARLY A MONTH BEFORE THE ENEMY WAS FINALLY DEFEATED. TOGETHER, THEY OFFER INSTRUCTION ON THE STRENGTHS AND LIMITATIONS OF AIRMOBILE WARFARE AND A PRIMER ON URBAN FIGHTING IN A COUNTERINSURGENCY ENVIRONMENT, SUBJECTS THAT CONTINUE TO BE A MAJOR ARMY INTEREST THROUGHOUT THE WORLD."

PACIFIC FLEET; YET THAT CRIPPLE ROSE TO TURN THE TIDE OF THE ENTIRE WAR AT MIDWAY. SHORTLY THEREAFTER, THE U. S. MARINES LAUNCHED ON GUADALCANAL AN OFFENSIVE WHICH WAS DESTINED TO END ONLY ON THE HOME ISLANDS OF THE EMPIRE. THE COUNTRY IN GENERAL, AND THE MARINE CORPS IN PARTICULAR, ENTERED WORLD WAR II IN A BETTER STATE OF PREPAREDNESS THAN HAD BEEN THE CASE IN ANY OTHER PREVIOUS

CONFLICT. BUT THAT IS A COMPARATIVE TERM AND DOES NOT MERIT MENTION IN THE SAME SENTENCE WITH THE DEGREE OF JAPANESE PREPAREDNESS. WHAT THE MARINE CORPS DID BRING INTO THE WAY, HOWEVER, WAS THE PRICELESS INGREDIENT DEVELOPED DURING THE YEARS OF PENCE: THE AMPHIBIOUS DOCTRINES AND TECHNIQUES THAT MADE POSSIBLE THE TRANS-PACIFIC ADVANCE – AND, FOR THAT MATTER, THE INVASION OF NORTH AFRICA AND THE EUROPEAN CONTINENT. BY PUBLISHING THIS OPERATIONS HISTORY IN A DURABLE FORM, IT IS HOPED TO MAKE THE MARINE CORPS RECORD PERMANENTLY AVAILABLE FOR THE STUDY OF MILITARY PERSONNEL, THE EDIFICATION OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC, AND THE CONTEMPLATION OF SERIOUS SCHOLARS OF MILITARY HISTORY.
